

WHM Installation Guide for macOS

This guide will walk you through the process of installing WHM (Work Hour Monitor) on your macOS system.

Install .NET 8.0 Runtime (If Not Already Installed)

WHM requires .NET 8.0 to run. Follow these steps to install it:


1. Visit the official .NET download page: <https://dotnet.microsoft.com/download/dotnet/8.0>
2. Under the **.NET Runtime 8.0** section, click on the **macOS** installer
3. Choose the appropriate installer for your Mac:
 1. **x64** for Intel-based Macs
 2. **ARM64** for Apple Silicon Macs (M1, M2, M3 chips)
4. Download and run the .pkg installer file
5. Follow the installation wizard prompts
6. Once complete, verify the installation by opening **Terminal** and running:

Step 1: Download the WHM Installer

1. Navigate to the official WHM download page
2. Click on the **Download WHM.dmg** button
3. Save the WHM.dmg file to your Downloads folder or preferred location


Step 2: Locate the Downloaded File

1. Open **Finder**
2. Navigate to your Downloads folder (or wherever you saved the file)
3. Locate the WHM.dmg file



Step 3: Mount the Disk Image


1. Double-click the WHM.dmg file to mount it
2. A new window will appear showing the WHM application icon



Step 4: Install WHM

1. In the mounted disk image window, you'll see the **WHM.app** icon and an **Applications** folder shortcut
2. Copy the **WHM.app** icon into the **Applications** folder
3. Wait for the copy process to complete

Note: You may need to authenticate with your administrator password during this step.



Step 5: Verify Installation

1. Open **Finder**
2. Navigate to **Applications** in the sidebar
3. Locate **WHM** in your applications list
4. The application is now successfully installed and ready to use



Step 6: Launch WHM

1. Double-click the **WHM** icon in your Applications folder, or
2. Use Spotlight Search (⌘ + Space) and type "WHM" to launch the application

First Launch Note: If you see a security warning stating the app is from an unidentified developer, go to **System Preferences > Security & Privacy** and click **Open Anyway**.

Uninstalling WHM

To remove WHM from your system:

1. Navigate to the **Applications** folder
2. Locate **WHM.app**
3. Drag it to the **Trash** or right-click and select **Move to Trash**
4. Empty your **Trash** to complete the uninstallation
